

## CONSTITUTION

(In accordance with the Societies Act of the Province of British Columbia)

1. The name of the Society is PORTAL PLAYERS DRAMATIC SOCIETY.
2. The main purpose of the Society is to foster the art of drama in its broadest sense through the following media:
  - a) By producing plays for private and public entertainment, and festival competition.
  - b) By educating our members and the general public about the performing arts, and encouraging the study of plays and all aspects related to theatrical performance.
  - c) By fostering a strong & active membership base, and encouraging new members to join & participate.
  - d) By fostering liaison and cooperation with other societies and groups having similar objectives.
3. The secondary purpose of the Society is to own, operate and maintain the real property & facility known as “The Capitol Theatre” at 4904 Argyle Street (*Amended Lot 3, Block 55, DL 1, Plan 197B – 4904 Argyle Street*) in Port Alberni, BC, in order to:
  - e) meet, rehearse and produce its own shows.
  - f) Host, rent to and produce non-Portal Players Dramatic Society events.
4. In the event of dissolution of Portal Players Dramatic Society, all assets remaining after payment of all debts and obligations shall be distributed equally between local chapters of the Heart Foundation and Cancer Society. The provision is unalterable.
